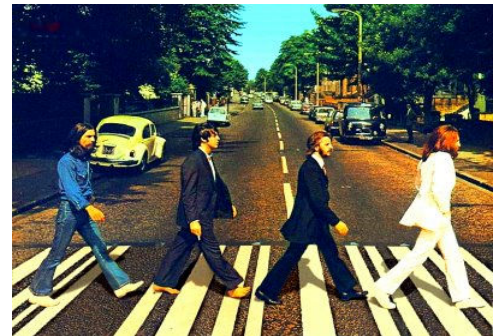
FEBRUARY 21 Allegash
